
Job Placement and Retention for FY2021-2022



100% of participants were placed at a job within 3 months of beginning their job search.



65% Increase in the number of participants who were placed in jobs in the community from the previous fiscal year.



67% Increase in the number of participants placed in employment and maintained employment for at least 90 days from the previous fiscal year.

Sometimes people need a little extra support when they are learning a job. Nevins Supported Employment program helps individuals find employment in the community and provides the support they need to be successful at their job.

Nichole has been working in the community since her early 20's. She initially began part-time work in the fast food industry, but it was through her volunteer work at a local adult day-care organization - Loving Touch - that she found the perfect fit. Nichole's role is diverse allowing her to broaden her skills from providing janitorial services, office organization to personal care where she serves snacks to clients.

While Nichole has proven to be a dependable employee, she gives much credit of her success to her job coach and friend, Delores Miller. Delores has worked alongside Nichole since 2010, helping her learn essential job skills, communicating and problem solving with supervisors and co-workers, understanding paychecks and the tasks that need to get done in a shift.

In addition to her job at Loving Touch, Nichole enjoys being helpful at home. She creates weekly

meal menus, shops for the ingredients and prepares meals for her family. Nichole's Mom, Elizabeth Matutu, who has sadly passed since this interview, shared her sentiments on how "Nevins has helped Nichole to have self esteem and be able to participate in society. She has learned about communication. Nichole used to be nonverbal, but being part of the Nevins family has empowered her to have confidence and a voice. We have enjoyed watching Nichole develop emotionally and live a fully enriched life". We are grateful that Mr. and Mrs. Matutu have entrusted Nevins to help Nichole achieve her life goals. Our condolences to Nichole and her family as they mourn the loss of their beloved family member. We promise to continue to create a community where "everyone has a sense of worth", as stated by Elizabeth.
