One thing you can be sure of is that we are always finding new ways to create opportunities for our friends here at Nevins.

Job Placement and Retention for FY2024-2025



100% of participants were placed at a job within 3 months of beginning their job search.



Increase in the number of participants who were placed in jobs in the community from the previous fiscal year.



Increase in the number of participants placed in employment and maintained employment for at least 90 days from the previous fiscal year.

A look by the numbers shows us that Nevins has had great success in placing our participants in jobs. All of our participants found a job within 3 months of starting their search. We had a 50% increase in participants being placed in jobs in the community, and ALL of them maintained employment for at least 90 days. In addition, Nevins was awarded over \$33,000 in grants including one for transportation, and one to benefit our Innovations Direct Support Professionals.
